The month of February will begin with our Valentine Unit, "A Special Time to Say I Love You", and the many ways we communicate; through the mail, by phone, etc. The Highlight of this unit will be our Valentine Party on February 14. At this time the children will be exchanging valentines with their classmates. There are 15 children in our class, counting your child. Please do not address the valentines to be given at the party.
