Dear Parent(s),

Welcome to Faith Preschool! Thank you for sharing your child with us. We are eagerly waiting a wonderful year full of fun and special learning experiences.

During the month of September, we will be busy getting acquainted with new friends and becoming more familiar with our new surroundings. We will be discovering the importance of sharing, helping, and being kind to one another. Later in the month we will be exploring outer space and discussing astronauts and the planets. We will also have a "Clifford Day" which the children really enjoy. The color of the month is **red** or **rojo** (pronounced roho). The shape of the month is **circle**, and the letters for the month are **A, S, and R**. The number of the month will be **4**.

Please praise and display your child's artwork. If your child comes home with no artwork, it only means we are keeping the artwork to decorate our room, or the artwork was not finished. This is especially true of our painting projects. They may need more time to dry.

We ask that you send your child to school in comfortable play clothes. We will be painting and cooking, and although we do wear smocks, we sometimes get a bit messy. We also suggest a sturdy tennis shoe, as we will be climbing and running during our large muscle playtime.

Red day is September 12th. We are asking each child to bring in something red to show in class. This item can be a toy or any unbreakable item that will fit inside your child's schoolbag. No play guns or knives please! Please put your child's name on that item to make certain it is returned to the correct child at dismissal time. We also ask that your child wear something red to reinforce our color of the month. Since we are teaching the children colors in Spanish, I will be giving you a Spanish color each month in the newsletter so that you may practice with your child. We will also be learning our numbers in Spanish. **Clifford day** is scheduled for September 21st. Your child can bring in anything "Clifford" or any other items they may want to share. We will be watching a Clifford movie and having a Clifford snack that day.

September is also safety month. We will learn about the importance of safety when crossing the street, strangers, answering the door at home, going to public places with our parents, and etc. We will be going on a safety walk. Officer Friendly will be out to visit the children on September 28th to discuss safety.

Each new month we will have a Christian Value to study. Our Christian Value for September is "kindness". "...do show kindness this day..." II Samuel 3:8

Please remember to read your child's newsletter every month. It contains important dates and information as to what your child will be doing each month. Please also check out the **snack calendar** each month. We really appreciate your snack donations. If at anytime you cannot send in snack, please let us know. We understand.

If your child should come home without a nametag, it simply means Ms. Domi and I feel comfortable that we know your child's name. We use nametags for various activities during the school year.
