Hello! We would like to welcome you and your child to Faith Preschool! We look forward to getting to know your child this year. For the month of September, we will be learning all about the routines of being at preschool and learning the names of our new friends. I have several activities geared toward these goals.

We will also be doing art projects and activities about our 5 Senses. Our Food Experience will be popping popcorn the “old fashioned way” in an electric popper and using all of our senses: seeing, smelling, hearing, touching, and tasting. Yum!

Our Moral focus this month is Kindness. We will be learning a Bible Verse (“Be kind and Compassionate to one another..”) and doing a puppet role-play activity modeling kind actions. Please reinforce this quality and Bible verse at home with your child.

Your child will also have a story time each day, calendar time, doing a class weather chart, learning months, days of the week, and colors songs! We will also say the flag pledge. We will be very busy!

Our **Red Show and Tell will be Tuesday September 13th**. Please have your child bring in something that is the color red! Please make sure the item fits in your child's book bag. We will have one show and tell each month. Please keep any other toys at home during “non-show and tell days”. Thank you!

On Tuesday, September 27 we will be meeting at the Brandt Pike Fire Station for a field trip at 10am! One parent and/or guardian needs to stay with the child the entire time. It's always a fun time for the kids to learn about fire safety and look at the fire and EMT vehicles. That will be our preschool for the day.

Lastly, we will be doing all kinds of fun art projects, and playing on the playground! Please have your child wear clothes that can get messy and **closed-toed shoes**. In addition, if your child is prone to having accidents, you may send a change of clothes for them to keep at the school. We just ask that you put the clothes in a ziploc bag labeled with their first and last name. Thanks!
